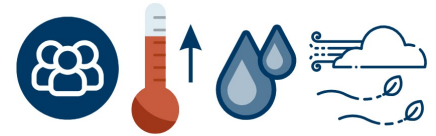


Climate Change Action Plan Workshop

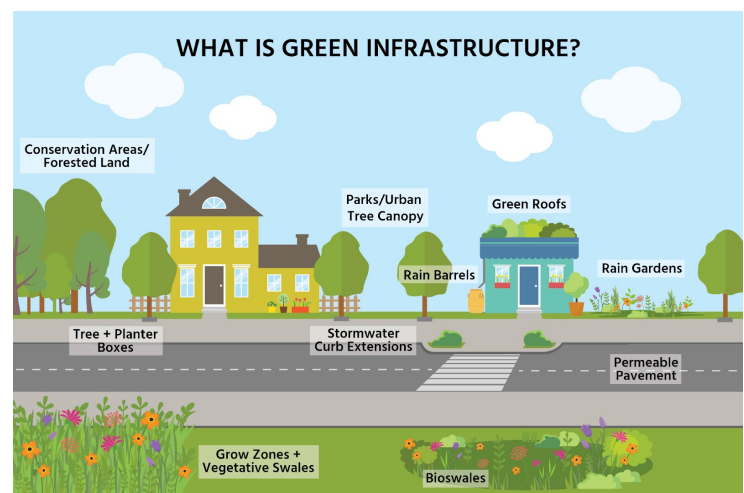
Climate Change in our region: Predictions in our area include *extreme weather, rising temperatures, flooding, drought*, and others. These effects impact many areas in our community such as human health, water and air quality, infrastructure, and ecological systems.



What are Nature-based solutions? Nature-based solutions are a range of measures that use the systems found in our natural environments to *PROTECT*, *RESTORE*, and/or *MANAGE* our ecological systems.

Examples of Nature-based solutions:

- Rain gardens
 - Bioswales
 - Biofilters
 - Green roofs
 - Greenways
 - Permeable pavement, pavement removal
 - Wetland restoration
